## **Alpine Advanced Rock Course**

### **Eastern Sierra Nevada, California**

#### **Alpine Rock Course II - 3 Days**



Alpine Rock Course II will feature a quick review of basic mountaineering techniques before moving on to advanced instruction on protection placement, route finding, alpine rock climbing techniques, and multi-pitch climbing. We will then attempt the selection of one-day Alpine rock climbs depending on the experience of the group. For the persons with previous rock climbing experience (outside or gym) or who has taken a Basic Alpine Course or Mountaineering Camp. Our Alpine Advanced Rock Course is three consecutive day trips, no need to carry heavy packs. Forest Service campgrounds located only minutes away from our daily meeting locations. Motels and Lodges are available in Mammoth Lakes, CA.

**Departure:** Mammoth Lakes, California

**Group Size:** 1-4 clients with 1-2 guides

**Guide to client ratio:** 2:1

**Experience Level:** Intermediate to Advanced Previous basic mountaineering experience including basic belays, knots. Or completion of our Alpine Rock Mountaineering Course.

**Itinerary:** Day one starts with an 8:00 am meeting at Mammoth Lakes Forest Service Visitor Center (see map). Drive to our rock-climbing site, located a short distance away, where rock skills will be practiced until late afternoon (4:00–5:00 pm). Meet day two & three you will set up the meeting time
