ADVANCED ICE & MIXED CLIMBING

LEE VINING/ JUNE LAKE, CALIFORNIA



General Description: For the experienced ice climber or experienced rock climber who has attended our Intermediate Ice Climbing Course. Your SWS Ice Climbing Guides is a challenging and exciting advanced technical ice course with plenty of time spent on the ice. Instruction includes:

- Advanced tool placement.
- Protection placement.
- Leading on-ice practice.
- Establishing the belay on the ice.
- Multi-pitch ice climbing.
- Mixed tool placement.
- Climbing techniques for unusual conditions.
- Using mono/dual point crampon technique.

Location: Lee Vining Canyon and/or June Lake area, depending on ice conditions.

Itinerary: We will meet in Lee Vining at 7:00 am on the first day and carpool/hike to the ice climbing area. Expect about a 20-30 minute drive and 1 hour or more hike up to the base of the ice climbing. Plan on returning to Lee Vining by late afternoon. Second day, leave Lee Vining by 7:00 am and return to the cars by 4:30 pm. This itinerary is subject to change due to weather, snow, and ice conditions at the time of the course.
